Dear Parents,

Please make a note of the following important points:

1. The final term written assessment will begin from **Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> March 2021**. We will be conducting oral assessments in each subject which will begin from **Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> February 2021**. The weightage of marks for each subject is as follows:

<b>Written Assessment</b>	<b>50</b>
<b>Oral assessment</b>	<b>10</b>

2. The oral assessment for each subject is as follows:

<b>English and Hindi</b>	Language assessment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dictation</li> <li>• Reading of any grade level text</li> <li>• Speaking activity</li> </ul> Total = 20 marks which will be finally reduced to 10 marks
<b>Math</b>	Mental Math
<b>Science and Social Studies</b>	Integrated Project

The oral assessments will be conducted during their respective subject periods over a period of ten days according to the schedule given by the subject teachers.

3. The written assessments will be conducted online. The procedure for conduct of assessment will be similar to that of the long assessment-1 conducted earlier. However, the question paper will be shared through **Google drive** in the online class only. You can print the paper if you want to. The paper will not be uploaded on the parent portal.
4. The students will write on loose sheets and mail the soft copy to the respective subject teacher at the designated time.
5. The timings for the written assessment will be from **9:00 to 11:30 am**. Students will log into their respective classrooms at 8:50 am.
  - Reading time will be from 9:00 – 9:15 am.
  - Students will write their paper from 9:15 am to 11:30 am.
  - 15 minutes will be given for uploading the pdf images/ mailing the images.
6. You are requested to mail the answer-sheets to the respective subject teachers on the day of the assessment at the stipulated time-11:45 am but not later than 12:15 pm.
7. Hard copies of the answer-sheets too will have to be submitted in the school. Kindly note the mailing of answer-sheets is essentially to ensure timely submission. **Teachers will evaluate only the hard copies of the answer sheets.** You are requested to put all the answer-sheets in one or two envelope/s, write the name, class and section of the child clearly on the envelope and drop the answer-sheets in the school on--

- I. Saturday, 13 March (between 8 am-2 pm) ---- classes III.**  
**II. Tuesday, 16 March (between 8 am-2 pm) --- classes IV & V.**

8. There will be regular online classes till **Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2021**. Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> March will be preparatory leave for students. Thereafter, non-evaluation days during examination period will be preparatory leave for students.
9. Retest of the final term examination will not be conducted under any circumstances. However, neutralisation of marks will happen in case prior approval for leave has been taken from the school.
10. Report cards will be uploaded on the parent portal on Friday , 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 by 2:00 p.m.
11. In addition to uploading of the report cards on the parent portal, **a PTM too will be held in the school on Saturday, 27<sup>th</sup> March,2021, if you so wish to meet the teachers.** The time slots for the same will be shared later.
12. Final examination syllabus, date-sheet, blue prints of question papers and details of the oral assessments have been uploaded along with this document. You can find them on the school website too under the “Downloads” link.
13. Please ensure that your ward prepares for/writes these examinations with utmost sincerity. Not preparing well will have an impact on his/her academic performance next year. We request you to, if possible, invigilate on our behalf.
